You need to log in to the VLE.


Your username will be initial+surname+year you started at LC.

Your password will be school unless you've changed it.


# **Getting to ActiveTeach**

Click on the link to **ActiveTeach** on the left hand side.



Make sure you pick the right tier for you.


When you click on a link, you'll get a screen like this:
